Changes in Temporary Permits

Ken Beth had forwarded a draft outlining the proposed change to the T-3 classification and the elimination of the T-4 classification. This would allow for events on Village property as long as all other requirements were met by the liquor holder. This license is limited to vendors that hold a village Class A license.

License Fees

The committee reviewed the fee schedule which increased a T-3 from \$50.00 to \$150.00.

After review Herman Fogal moved/Jimmy Taylor seconded to recommend the changes to the Village Board. Changes will be effective immediately following Village Board passage of the Ordinances.

Beer and Wine Tasting

The committee discussed allow an event where outside vendors could bring alcohol in for tasting. There is currently no provision in the Code for this type of event.

Brewery Licenses

The Committee discuss the possibility of a brewery location in the Village. There is currently no provision in the Code for this type of event.
