Public Participation Rules

The Village Board has adopted the following procedures with respect to citizens addressing its meetings:

- 1) Speaker shall be limited to 3 minutes to address the Board. The Village Clerk shall keep time for all speakers. The Clerk shall provide all speakers with a 30-second warning and shall notify all speakers of the conclusion of their allotted time.
- 2) Speaker shall act and speak with decorum and conform to conventional social manners in speech, writing, dress and behavior.
- 3) Speaker must be concise and not repetitive of himself/herself or other speakers.

Statement Regarding Our Compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)
