Mr. Stubblefield moved to approve a loan in the amount of \$30,000 for 7 yrs. at 4% to be secured by a second mortgage on the property and a second position in the business assets. Mr. Loschen seconded the motion. Motion carried, all voting "aye".

Loan Request from Gallery 109

Jeremy and Lana Tengwall are the owners of Gallery 109. They have requested a loan in the amount of \$37,000 to start a business at 109 E. Sangamon, the space formerly occupied by Judge's Photography. The business would sell discount furniture in a Boutique setting. The committee discussed the request and had several concerns. After discussion the Committee directed Denny Long to contact Mr. & Mrs. Tengwall to get clarification on several issues:

- What building improvements are needed to pass Inspection
- Is there a possibility of renting vs. purchasing building
- Will Mr. Tengwall continue his current employment
- What are the salary cost
- What is the target market

Mr. Long stated he would meet with the Tengwalls and report his findings at the next Micro Loan meeting.

There was no action on this item.
