

**Rantoul Village Board of Trustees**  
**Regular Study Session**  
**June 5, 2012**

A regular Study Session of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Rantoul was held at 6:15 P.M., President Neal Williams presiding. President Williams called the proceeding to order.

**Roll Call**

The Village Clerk called the roll, finding the following members physically present:

Trustees, Tony Brown, Margurette Carter, Jennifer Fox, Hank Gamel, and Herman Fogal – 5.

The following representatives of Village departments were also present:

Bruce Sandahl, Administrator; Kenneth Beth, Attorney; Scot Brandon, Comptroller; Ken Waters, Fire Chief; Rich Thomas, Recreation; Greg Hazel, Public Works Director; Mike Loschen, Community Development; Dan Culkin, Inspection; and Village Clerk Mike Graham.

**Public Participation**

There was no Public Participation by Rantoul Citizens.

**Items from the Mayor**

The Mayor turned over the discussion to Ken Beth, Village Attorney. Mr. Beth explained that a local Lawyer representing the T & T Tavern concerning Video Poker Machines had requested a change in the Village Code. The current Village Ordinance in this area is not consistent with current State of Illinois Law. Mr. Beth therefore proposed to amend Chapter 20 of the Ordinance to create an exception for these gaming devices which would bring the Village Ordinance in compliance with Illinois State Law. Mr. Beth further compared this exception to the Ordinance as allowing an establishment to sell State Lottery Tickets.

The Village Board had no problems with the proposed changes and this will be taken to the Regular Village Board Meeting on Tuesday June 12, 2012 for final action.

**Items from Trustees**

Trustee Gamel asked about a Recycling Program for the Village of Rantoul, like other communities have. Mr. Sandhal, Village Administrator, explained that Area Disposal, Inc. currently has a Recycling Service available for those customers

who wish to pay for this additional garbage pick-up service, but he and the Staff would discuss what could be done to expand this program throughout the Village of Rantoul.

### **Items from the Clerk**

The Clerk had no additional items for the agenda.

### **Items from the Administrator**

Mr. Sandahl had no items to bring to the Board.

### **Monthly Department Reports**

The Department Heads in attendance presented their respective oral departmental reports. The Department Heads written reports were included in the Board packets distributed to the Trustees prior to the Study Session. Those reports are in the official board file.

### **Items from the Consent Agenda**

The Trustees had no comment on these items and these will be taken to the Regular Board Meeting for action.

### **Items from Public Works**

- Purchase two substation circuit breakers for the Industrial Substation.
- Preliminary & Design Engineering Agreement for Route 45 and Flessner Avenue Intersection with Baxter & Woodman, Inc.
- Local Agency Agreement between the Village of Rantoul & IDOT for the Flessner Avenue Intersection.

The Board had no objections or discussion with respect to these items and these items will be taken to the Board Meeting, Tuesday, June 12, 2012 for final action.

### **Items from Inspection**

- Purchase property at 1029 Eastview Drive.
- Recommendation from the Plan Commission to approve a 2-Lot Subdivision Final Plat. This item was removed from the agenda by Dan Culkin, the Inspection Department Director, as he explained that this item was not ready to be discussed or acted upon at this time. This Item will be brought up at future Village of Rantoul Board Meetings when all of the details have been worked out.

The Trustees had very little discussion on the purchase of 1029 Eastview Drive and this item will be taken to the Regular Board Meeting June 12, 2012 for action.

**Items from the Recreation Department**

- Purchase of Toro Groundmaster 4100-D rotary mower and Toro Groundmaster 3180-D front deck mower from MTI, Inc.
- Purchase of rubber flooring for Athletic Building.

The Trustees had no discussion on these items and both of these items will be taken to the Regular Board Meeting on June 12, 2012.
