<p><b>SUMMARY HIGHLIGHTS:</b></p> <p>I recently learned through the IML that the legislature adopted HB 6162 concerning sick leave. This new law takes effect January 1, 2017 and creates the Employee Sick Leave Act to provide that employees may use personal sick leave benefits provided by the employer for absences due to illness, injury or medical appointment of the employee's child, spouse, sibling, parent, mother-in-law, father-in-law, grandchild, grandparent or stepparent, for reasonable periods of time as the employee's attendance may be necessary, on the same terms upon which the employee is able to use sick leave benefits for the employee's own illness or injury.</p> <p>Recently the board approved changes to the village sick leave policy to include grandchildren, but we did not include grandparents and siblings. Due to this new statute, the village needs to update its sick leave policy to include grandparents and siblings. This will go into effect immediately.</p>	
<p><b>RECOMMENDED ACTION:</b> I recommend approving the ordinance amending the personal code to mirror language contained in the Employee Sick Leave Act</p>

<b>SUMMARY HIGHLIGHTS:</b> <p>This Agenda item provides for the repair of Jackson Hall (building 96) which was damaged during the June 2016 wind storm. This building is located at the intersection of Eagle Drive and Flessner Avenue and had the northwest section of metal siding torn away from the building's frame. The general condition of the high bay area is good and this project will enclose and protect that portion of the building.</p> <p>This project was assembled by Gorski Reifsteck Architects and was advertised in early November. Bids were received at 2:00pm on December 14, 2016. Five (5) bids were submitted and a copy of the bid tabulation and the Architect's letter of recommendation is attached for your reference. Schomburg and Schomburg provided the lowest responsive Base Bid in the amount of \$29,905.91. A contingency fund of \$1,500.00 is requested to address any additional issues that may arise.</p> <p>An insurance payment has been received which will fund this repair work.</p>	
<b>RECOMMENDED ACTION:</b> Authorize the award of a contract with Schomburg and Schomburg in the amount of \$29,905.91 and authorize a contingency fund in the amount of \$1,500.00 for the repair of the northwest corner of Jackson Hall.

Bids were received Wednesday December 14, 2016 for the Rantoul Building 96 Siding Replacement project. Five (5) bids from General Contractors were received, opened, and read aloud (please see attached bid tabulation sheet). We have notified all bidders of the results. The lowest apparently successful bidder is as follows:

Schomburg & Schomburg Construction, Inc.	General Contract	\$29,905.91

The average of the bids received was \$50,243, or approximately 40% higher than the lowest bid. We have discussed the bid results and the scope of the project work with Schomburg & Schomburg Construction, Inc., and they confirmed that they are satisfied with their bid amount. They've indicated that they have reviewed the site and the construction documents, discussed all items which generated contractor questions during the bidding process, and have acknowledged all addenda. They explained that they are very familiar with this type of work and understand what will be required. They indicated on their Bid Form that they will be able to complete the work in forty-five days, which in our opinion seems to be a reasonable timeframe for the scope of work involved once approvals of shop drawings and purchase orders are made. It is our opinion after discussing the work with Schomburg & Schomburg that the bidding documents were sufficient for providing a competitive bid.

After our discussion of the project work we believe that Schomburg & Schomburg Construction, Inc. understands the scope of work and are ready to proceed when authorized. Gorski Reifsteck Architects recommends that Schomburg & Schomburg Construction, Inc. be awarded the contract for this project work.





**ORDINANCE NO. 2507**

**AN ORDINANCE  
SUPPLEMENTING AND AMENDING SECTION 24-177(a) OF  
THE RANTOUL CODE IN CONNECTION WITH SICK LEAVE ALLOWANCE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF  
THE VILLAGE OF RANTOUL, ILLINOIS, as follows:**

**Section 1. Amendment.** That subsection (a), entitled "Allowance", of Section 24-177, entitled "Sick Leave", of Chapter 24, entitled "PERSONNEL", as supplemented and amended, be and the same is hereby supplemented and amended to provide as follows:

**Sec. 24-177. – Sick Leave.**

- (a) *Allowance.* Subject to the applicable provisions of this article any full-time employee (and any part-time employee on a prorated basis) covered by this article shall accrue 3.70 hours of sick leave for each completed pay period of employment, provided that the number of sick leave hours that may be accumulated by any such full-time employee (and part-time employee on a prorated basis) shall not exceed 2,080 hours at any one time. Sick leave shall be allowed for: the personal illness, injury or medical appointment of any such full-time employee or of any such part-time employee, or the illness, injury or medical appointment of his spouse or child (including stepchild), parent (including stepparent and spouse's parents), grandchild (including a child of any stepchild) or grandparent if the care of any such person by any such full-time employee or any such part-time employee is medically necessary.

**Section 2. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective following its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

This ordinance is hereby passed, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, by the concurrence of a majority of the members of the Corporate Authorities then holding office at a regular meeting on the date set forth below.
