Below are the changes to the hauler RFP based on the pre-bid meeting in December. These changes were unanimously approved by the garbage hauler committee established by the Mayor and Village Board. They are summarized below with the corresponding pages of the RFP noted. Feel free to contact me at jfiegenschuh@village.rantoul.il.us if you have any further questions.

Refuse Collection

Section B, Refuse Receptacles-Entire Section is deleted from RFP (Page 3).

Section B New, Pick-up-Residents can put up to two 96-gallon totes out each week. The Contractor is required to provide one 96-gallon tote at no cost to the resident. Each additional tote must be purchased by the resident through the contractor (Page 3).

Page 18 of the RFP contains a section where contractors shall note the prices for an additional refuse and recycling tote.

Recycling Collection

Section A, General Services- Recycling services are required to be provided by the contractor and shall be part of the base bid; however it is now an opt-in program for the resident. The resident will contact the contractor to establish recycling services and the contractor shall provide at no cost, one 96-gallon recycling tote to the resident. The recycling will coincide with refuse pick-up (Page 4).

Section B, Recycling Materials to be Collected- The contractor, through the RFP, will provide a list to the Village of all materials that qualify for their recycling program (Page 4).

General Requirements

Section A, Municipal Facilities- Add PW Works Office/ Power Plant & PW Warehouse (recycling only). Rantoul Aquatic Center is changed to May-September only (Page 5).

Section B, Special Events-Added language that construction debris shall not equate to more than 2.5 cubic yards (Page 5).

Section F, Service Implementation-The contract will go into effect on July 1, 2015 instead of May 1, 2015 (Page 6).

Compensation

Section B, Billing-Billing to the Village shall be once per month (Page 6).

Section C, Franchise Fee- Payment of the franchise fee shall be negotiated at the time of the contract (Page 7).

General Provisions

Section E, Performance Bond- The \$500,000 performance bond shall remain the same (Page 10).

Section L, Flow and Transportation of Refuse-A contractor shall be required to dispose of all refuse collected from Rantoul customers at any transfer station or similar garbage transportation and/or processing facility located within Rantoul except in the event that any then existing contract obligates such contractor to use another facility for the balance of the such contract term (Page 12).

Contents of Proposal

Section E, Proposal Deadline-The proposal deadline has been pushed back to Friday February 13th at 5:00 p.m. (Page 14).

Optional Services Offered, Appendix B

Section B, General Services-Contractors may submit a bid for the optional service of yard waste collection. The proposal shall be submitted as an alternate and any costs associated will be above the base bid proposal (Page 19)

Section C, Yard Waste Receptacles- Clarified some language and changed to: All yard waste must be placed in a water proof plastic or metal container (Page 19).
