ORDINANCE NO. 2587

**AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING THE PAY PLAN IN
CONNECTION WITH PUBLIC WORKS CERTIFICATION PAY**

WHEREAS, under and pursuant to Ordinance No. 2568, passed and approved on April 17, 2018, the President and Board of Trustees (the “**Corporate Authorities**”) of the Village of Rantoul, Champaign County, Illinois (the “**Village**”) adopted the Pay Plan along with the Annual Budget in and for the fiscal year of the Village beginning April 1, 2018 and ending on April 30, 2019 (the “**Pay Plan**”); and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village now desire to supplement and amend that part of the Pay Plan under the heading “Municipal Clerk Certification Pay”.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RANTOUL, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. Supplement and Amendment. That the part of the Pay Plan under the heading “Municipal Clerk Certification Pay” be and the same is hereby supplemented and amended to provide as follows:

Public Works Certification Pay

Each Officer or Employee elected to the position of Village Clerk or appointed to the position of Deputy Village Clerk who becomes and continues to maintain status as a “Certificate Municipal Clerk or Master Municipal Clerk” shall receive such additional annual compensation in such amount as is specified below for the applicable class of such certification as follows:


Certificate Municipal Clerk	\$600.00 per year
Master Municipal Clerk	\$1,200.00 per year

Such additional annual compensation shall not become effective until the fiscal year of the Village beginning May 1, 2019; provided further that any such annual compensation payable to an elected Village Clerk shall not take effect until after the current term of office of the elected Village Clerk.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect as of May 1, 2019, following its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

This Ordinance is hereby passed, the “**ayes**” and “**nays**” being called, by the concurrence of a majority of the members of the President and Board of Trustees then holding office at a regular meeting on the date set forth below.
