

Stormwater Drainage Terminology

Ordinance

The Stormwater Drainage Utility Fee was implemented by the Village Board of Trustees, upon recommendation of the Stormwater Drainage Committee in December of 2000. The fee was first collected for calendar year 2001. (Reference the code, Chapter 40, Section 40-440)

Stormwater Drainage Committee

The Stormwater Drainage Committee meets on an as-needed basis to address stormwater drainage issues within the Village.

Budget – Levy Amount

The annual Stormwater Drainage Utility Fee levy amount is set by the Village Board each year during the budget process. The amount is based upon a recommended budget created by the Public Works Department.

Billing Address

The Village mails the Stormwater Drainage Utility Fee to the “Taxpayer” according to the records of the Champaign County Supervisor of Assessments Office. We cannot bill the Stormwater Drainage Utility Fee to another address. If you need to change your billing address, you will need to change the billing address for your property tax bill also. Service Address

The Village of Rantoul Inspection Department maintains the service address for each taxable unit, also known as a parcel. If you believe the service address is incorrect, please contact the Inspection Department at 217-892-6826 or by e-mail.

Acreage and Land Use

Payments

Payments are collected by the Customer Service Office, located in the Municipal Building at 333 South Tanner Street. Please direct questions regarding amount payable, due date, and previous payments to the Customer Service Office 217-892-6800.

Accounting

Interest, Late Fees, and Liens are administered by the Accounting Division. Past due accounts are assessed a late fee of 5%. Interest of 2% per month will be charged on any unpaid balance. The Village

may place a lien against taxable units with an outstanding balance. If a lien is filed a \$25 administrative fee plus \$102 recording fee will be added to the account. Inquiries regarding Late Fees, Interest, or Liens should be directed to Angie Schultz, 217-892-6831 or by e-mail.

Appeals

The Village Code provides for an appeals process for this utility fee. Appeals should be filed in writing to Pat Chamberlin, Comptroller, at 333 South Tanner Street, Rantoul, Illinois 61866.
