



**ORDINANCE 2748**

**AN ORDINANCE  
AMENDING ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 16 OF THE RANTOUL VILLAGE CODE  
PERTAINING TO FIRE DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, Article II of Chapter 16 of the Village Code established the Fire Department of the Village; and,

**WHEREAS**, Division 2 of Article II provides for the organization and membership of the Fire Department; and,

**WHEREAS**, Section 16-47 currently provides the positions of Fire Chief, Assistant Fire Chief, Captain, and Firefighter; and,

**WHEREAS**, in order to develop and maintain long-term goals and objectives, as well as to provide an improved structure for performance of duties, the Fire Chief desires to amend Section 16-47 to create additional supervisory positions and a new organizational structure; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Village President and Board of Trustees desire to amend Section 16-47 to create additional positions and a new organizational structure for the Fire Department.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RANTOUL, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS**, as follows:

**Section 1. Amendment.** That Chapter 16, entitled “Fire Protection and Prevention”, Article II, entitled “Fire Department”, Division 2, entitled “Organization, Membership, Duties”, be amended to read as set forth as follows:

**Sec. 16-47. - Authority of ranking officers.**

The Fire Chief and the other members of the Fire Department shall rank in the order designated for such positions as set forth below, and the Fire Chief or other member of the highest rank shall take command of the Fire Department and direct the management and affairs thereof for any purpose involving the duties of the fire department as authorized by this chapter.

- 1) Fire Chief
- 2) Deputy Chief
- 3) Assistant Chief
- 4) Captain
- 5) Lieutenant
- 6) Firefighter


**Section 2. Effective Date.** The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective following its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

**Section 3. Conflict.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

**Section 4. Publication.** The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause this Ordinance to be published in pamphlet form.

This Ordinance is hereby passed, the “ayes” and “nays” being called, by the concurrence of a majority of the members of the Corporate Authorities then holding office on the date set forth below.
