



**AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 18 “LAW ENFORCEMENT” OF THE
RANTOUL CODE IN CONNECTION WITH APPOINTMENTS**

WHEREAS, Rantoul Code Chapter 18 contains provisions concerning the appointment of individuals to the position of police officer; and,

WHEREAS, the Rantoul Village Board desires to update and amend Section 18-21 of Chapter 18 concerning such appointments.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RANTOUL, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. Amendment. That Section 18-21(e)(2) of Article II, entitled “Police Department”, of Chapter 18, entitled “Law Enforcement”, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

(2) In filling a position vacancy involving the Police Officer position, the Chief of Police shall separately consider and select any qualified candidate from the persons named on the eligibility list. The Chief of Police may separately select any of the persons so named, without regard for the number of times they may have been considered in the past, or their position on the list in comparison to any of the other persons considered.

Section 2. Effective Date. The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective following its passage, approval and publication as required by law.

Section 3. Conflict. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

Section 4. Publication. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause this Ordinance to be published in pamphlet form.

This Ordinance is hereby passed, the “ayes” and “nays” being called, by the concurrence of a majority of the members of the Corporate Authorities then holding office on the date set forth below.
