Pesticide Application Notice

Pursuant to Public Act 103-0976, the public is hereby notified that the Village of Rantoul Public Works Department, or a contractor working on behalf of the Village of Rantoul Public Works Department, intends to apply a pesticide to a public right-of-way if such pesticide application is necessary. This refers to the public right-of-way that the Village of Rantoul, through its employees or contractors, is responsible for maintaining – key areas including certain vacant lots, stormwater detention basins, rain gardens, ditch lines, overpasses and medians. The public is further notified of the following:

1. The intended location, date range, and range of times of pesticide application are:

March 1 – March 31, 2026, 7:00am-3:00pm, Monday to Friday. Locations - Village right-of way including (but not limited to) Village-owned and maintained trees, shrubs/bushes, grassy areas, parking lots, stormwater facilities, planter beds/plantings, tree grates, ponds and lift stations, electric sub stations.

2. The brand name, common name, and scientific name of each product that may be used is:

3. The type(s) of pesticide contained in any product that may be applied include:

4. The reason for the use of the product(s) is: The treatment of turf grass, removal/prevention of weeds and pests.
