

ORDINANCE 2801

**AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF PERSONAL
PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF RANTOUL, ILLINOIS
(Fire Department Pickup Truck)**

WHEREAS, the Village of Rantoul, Champaign County, Illinois (the “**Village**”) is a Home Rule unit under and pursuant to Section 6(a) of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and is authorized to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including the power to authorize the sale, conversion, conveyance, trade-in, or other disposition (any of which is collectively referred to herein as a “**conveyance**”) of any of its personal property; and,

WHEREAS, Section 14-106 of the Village Code authorizes the sale or disposition of surplus property valued at more than \$5,000.00 in such manner as the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village (the “**Corporate Authorities**”) may authorize, with or without advertising, or competitive bid for any such conveyance; and

WHEREAS, the Village owns an item of personal property consisting of a 1993 Ford F-250 XLT (the “**Personal Property**”), which the Corporate Authorities find has or will have an estimated value of more than \$5,000.00, is or will be no longer necessary or useful to, or in the best interests of, the Village to retain; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities believe it is in the best interests of the Village to sell the Personal Property by sealed competitive bid.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RANTOUL, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. The Personal Property as described above is hereby directed to be sold by sealed competitive bids.

Section 2. From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, the proper officers, employees, and agents of the Village are hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to do all such acts and things, and to execute and deliver all documents and instruments as may be necessary to complete the conveyance of such Personal Property and to carry out the intent and accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance in accordance with its terms.


